



THE “SUIT YOURSELF” STIPEND PROGRAM

The goal of the SUNY New Paltz Career Resource Center’s “SUIT YOURSELF” Stipend Program is to enable eligible students to purchase professional attire for job interviews with a “clothing award” of up to \$200. The “SUIT YOURSELF” stipend fund offers monetary support for New Paltz students, who because of financial constraints, would not be in the position to purchase appropriate professional attire for an interview. Such interviews could be for an internship, student teaching placement, or full-time employment opportunity. The “SUIT YOURSELF” stipend was created with the understanding that for the majority of college students buying a suit can be a financial burden. The “SUIT YOURSELF” stipend recognizes the importance image plays in a recruiter’s or administrator’s decision regarding an applicant for a position. This stipend shows a commitment on the part of the Career Resource Center in investing in the short and long-term career goals of SUNY New Paltz students.

The “SUIT YOURSELF” Stipend Program is open to students who meet the below criteria. **The clothing stipend is up to \$200 and will be awarded to a maximum of twenty students each semester. The application deadline date for the Spring 2008 semester is April 4th.**

Student Eligibility

- Declared major in one of the academic degree programs at SUNY New Paltz
- Demonstrated financial need
- Must be in good academic standing with the University
- Matriculated undergraduate or graduate student attending SUNY New Paltz
- Seeking an internship, student teaching placement or full-time professional job

Application Procedure

All Applicants are asked to submit:

- **A completed application form available from the Career Resource Center, HAB 705 or online at <http://www.newpaltz.edu/careers> (Part I)**
- Documentation of financial need, as described on the included budget worksheet (part II) .
- A copy of a current unofficial transcript .
- A one-page personal statement supporting your request for a “Suit Yourself” Stipend explaining how this clothing allowance will benefit your internship or job search activities.
- By signing the application (part 1) you agree that if awarded this clothing stipend, you will provide the Career Resource Center with a receipt of the clothing purchased as well as bring in your selection so that a Career Resource Center staff member may approve of the purchase as meeting the criteria of “professional dress”. In addition, the recipient is asked to participate in a campus-wide fashion show on how to dress professionally for an interview.

Complete application packets (application form, documentation of financial need, unofficial transcript, & essay) for Spring 2008 must be received by the close of business on April 4, 2008.

Drop off the application packet to the Career Resource Center, HAB 705.

**SUNY New Paltz students are only eligible to receive this clothing stipend award once in their college career.*
