_____ Fail: portfolio fails to meet the objectives of the course. The folder does not fulfill the program requirements for portfolio assessment, and/or the work it contains does not fulfill the course objectives. The writing is at or below **LEVEL 3** on the SUNY New Paltz grading scale.
