Graduation Requirements

1. You must return the declaration of major form, proof of 30 documented hours & fingerprinting
2. You must complete your fingerprints and provide us with proof before being allowed to declare your elem ed major. You cannot S/U prerequisite or methods courses.
3. You must continually maintain an overall GPA of at least a 2.75 to remain in the Childhood Program.
4. You must receive a "C" or better in all the prerequisite courses (except EED370&415 B-)
5. You must receive a "B-" or better in all education courses and can only repeat once.
6. You will be responsible for making sure all your General Education, your liberal art major, and all education requirements are met including taking a Writing Intensive course, a total of at least 120 credits, 45 upper division, and 60 liberal art courses before graduating. (See progress report).
7. You must complete all prerequisite and Methods 1 courses before being allowed into Methods 2 or 3. You must complete **ALL** education and major requirements as well as completing workshops & fingerprints before being allowed into student teaching or fieldwork
8. You must receive an "S" in all field experiences and student teaching.
9. You must have an overall GPA of at least 2.75 to get into your methods and student teaching semesters as well as EED370 and EED415.
10. You are responsible for arranging transportation to all fieldwork experiences. Your placements will be within 45 miles & you cannot pick your own placements.

Certification Requirements

1. Must receive a passing score on the three required NYS Teacher Certification tests (LAST, ATS-W, CST-Multi Subject).
2. Must complete the two-hour seminar for both the Child Abuse Mandated Reporting and SAVE. If you take it anywhere other than SUNY New Paltz, you must supply proof to records. If you take either or both here, proof of completion will appear on your transcripts. No certificates will be given out.
3. You must complete the requirement for fingerprinting before fieldwork and provide proof.

All requirements for the Childhood Education program have been explained to me at the time of my being accepted into the program and they are listed above. I fully understand these requirements.
