### HOW TO APPLY FOR A SUNY NEW PALTZ SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria by which scholarships are awarded are provided under the heading of each scholarship. Do not apply for a particular scholarship if you do not fulfill the necessary requirements. It is in the best interest of the applicant to answer all questions and complete all applications fully and neatly. Submit completed applications, transcripts and recommendations as follows to "Scholarship Committee":

**Admission Scholarships:** Candidates are selected by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions based on outstanding academic achievement and ability to meet the spirit of the scholarship. For more information contact the Office of Undergraduate Admissions, Hopfer Center, (845) 257-3200.

#### **Alumni Association Scholarships:**

- Use the "Alumni Association" application form provided in the Appendix.
- List all scholarships for which you are applying, on the application.
- Only one set of recommendations are required for those applying for more than one Alumni Association Scholarship.
- Completed applications must be submitted directly to the Office of Alumni Affairs, Hopfer Center.

#### **Departmental Scholarships**

- Use the "Departmental" application form provided in the Appendix.
- A **separate** application form is required for **each scholarship**.
- Completed applications must be submitted directly to the department office.

#### **General Scholarships**

- Use the "General" application form provided in the Appendix.
- List all scholarships for which you are applying on the application.
- Only one set of recommendations are required for those applying for more than one General Scholarship.
- Completed applications must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office, HAB 607.

### **TRANSCRIPTS**

All scholarship applications, must be accompanied by a current copy of your SUNY New Paltz student transcript (**unofficial**), including the fall 2010 semester (one for each scholarship category is sufficient). Transfer students must also provide copies of transfer transcripts. Transcripts are available online through the SUNY New Paltz web site – [www.newpaltz.edu](http://www.newpaltz.edu) - or for a nominal fee, at the Office of Records and Registration, HAB 19

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Each applicant must submit three recommendations from faculty or professional staff members for an application to be complete unless the criteria states otherwise. If you are applying for more than one scholarship, you must include a set of recommendations (copies) for each additional scholarship. **Students applying under the category General Scholarship need provide only ONE set.** At least one recommendation must be from a full-time instructional faculty member unless criteria states otherwise. When requesting a recommendation (forms provided in Appendix) from a faculty or staff member, note your deadline to the individual. **It is the student's responsibility to be certain that this deadline is met.** Therefore, students should follow up on requests carefully to guarantee a complete application. Recommendations must be included in the packet for your application to be complete.

### **DOCUMENTATION OF FINANCIAL NEED**

Many scholarships require documentation of financial need. Depending on the requirements of the specific scholarship, documentation (copies) may include one or more of the following:

- Tax Return
- W-2 Wage and Tax Statement
- Financial Aid Application
- Student Accounts Invoice
- Statement of Financial Need (short paragraph)

All scholarships require proof of GPA. Please include a copy of one of the following:

- Recent Grade Transcript (Office of Records or New Paltz Web Site)
- Dean's List "Letter of Congratulations"

**All applications, transcripts and recommendations must be submitted to the appropriate office by Friday, April 15, 2011, 4:30 p.m.**

### **AWARDS (Academic year 2011-2012)**

Scholarships awarded to students will be distributed in two parts: 50% will be applied to the student's account during the first semester, and the remaining 50% will be applied during the second semester as long as the student continues to meet the criteria of the scholarship.

Results will be announced by e-mail by July 2011.

Only students receiving awards will be notified.

Established and reviewed by the SUNY New Paltz Alumni Association, these awards are designed to meet financial need and to encourage strong academic performance as well as contributions to the college community. These scholarships will be awarded annually for the fall (2010) semester and will be applied toward tuition owed. Awards include the following:

- C. Have a cumulative average of at least 3.0;
- D. Submit evidence of SUNY New Paltz academic achievement and honors;
- E. Submit evidence of well defined academic and professional goals;
- F. Describe significant contributions made to SUNY New Paltz and the community;
- G. Submit three recommendations, two from SUNY New Paltz teaching faculty; and
- H. Submit a current New Paltz transcript.
- I. Student must have completed 24 credits at New Paltz by application deadline.

## GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

### Frank G. Elliot Family Scholarship

Established in 1998 by the estate of Frank G. Elliott, to support women residents of Ulster County pursuing a degree at SUNY New Paltz. This scholarship shall continue to be awarded on an annual basis to the original recipient for the remainder of her course of study towards an initial degree at New Paltz, assuming the recipient continues to meet the scholarship criteria.

The selection and criteria process will be as follows:

- A. First preference will be given to women residents of Ulster County
- B. Applicant must be a full-time matriculated student
- C. Recipient must maintain good academic standing

### Gertrude M. Elliott Scholarship

Grace E. Elliott, a lifelong resident of New Paltz, passed away in 1997. She designated a portion of her estate to SUNY New Paltz for the establishment of a scholarship fund named in honor of her mother, Gertrude M. Elliott, a Clionian sister and a member of the Class of 1926. The Gertrude M. Elliott Scholarship provides scholarships annually for one or more women students from either New Paltz or Yonkers, New York. Scholarships shall be awarded to a sophomore and continue to be awarded on an annual basis toward an initial degree providing academic requirements are maintained.

The selection and criteria process will be as follows:

- A. Must be a resident of New Paltz or Yonkers, NY.
- B. Must be a woman of sophomore class standing or above at SUNY New Paltz at the time the award is made.
- C. Must be a full-time matriculated student.
- D. Must maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average.

### Kurt Haas Memorial Scholarship

Kurt Haas, Professor Emeritus of Psychology, was the first individual in his family to attend college. He authored seven books, including *Abnormal Psychology* which was translated into Spanish, and *Understanding Sexuality* which was translated into Chinese.

This scholarship award was established by the family, friends and colleagues of Kurt Haas in honor of his many years of dedicated service and to keep his memory and the ideals he stood for alive and thriving at SUNY New Paltz.

The selection and criteria process will be as follows:

- A. Be a full-time matriculated student.
- B. Have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- C. Be a first generation college student.
- D. Demonstrate financial need.
- E. Submit two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a current faculty member.

The selection and criteria process will be as follows:

- A. This is a one-year, non-renewable scholarship available to entering full-time freshmen or full-time transfer students (preference will be given to a student whose education has been interrupted for a period of time) who intend to major in Business Administration or Accounting.
- B. A 3.0 grade point average for transfer students and a 90 high school average and 1100 SAT I score for freshman is required. Students who have demonstrated motivation, but have lower averages because of personal hardship, will also be considered.

- B. Recipient must have been admitted to an upper-division program in the School of Business with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 or be enrolled in the school's MBA program with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 at SUNY New Paltz.
- C. Preference will be given to applicants who are active student members of Management Association and the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM).
- D. Candidates must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in human resource management.
- E. Students must submit a written statement outlining their goals and two recommendations.

- B. Cumulative high school average of 85 or better or a minimum grade point average of 2.75 to be considered for this scholarship. Awardees must maintain a grade point average of 2.75 in their course work to continue to receive this endowment.
- C. The decision regarding bestowing this award is based primarily on merit, with secondary consideration given to students in financial need.

## CLASSICS

### Bernard Aratowsky Memorial Scholarship

- B. Applicant must have completed a minimum of six credits in ancient history, Greek or Latin at the time of application.
- C. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.33 (B+) in the field of classics.
- D. Applicant may be required to submit an essay dealing with the study of the classics.

## COMMUNICATION DISORDERS

### Communication Disorders Departmental Scholarship

Offered to a student who demonstrates financial need, academic achievement and clinical promise in the field. All applicants are required to submit an essay of approximately 300 words expressing how they meet the criteria. Faculty recommendations are not required, however applicants may add letters of support to their application from faculty and/or other individuals who can address the applicant's practical experience in the field.

The selection and criteria process will be as follows:

- A. To be eligible, applicant must be a student in their junior year majoring in Communication Disorders at SUNY New Paltz.
- B. Applicant must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0.

This award is based primarily on a student's ability to show financial need and clinical promise in the field. Need can be demonstrated through one or more of the following; tax returns, W-2 wage and tax statements, financial aid application and/or student account invoice. Clinical promise can be demonstrated through the essay required of each applicant. Additionally, applicants can provide letters of support from faculty and/or other individuals who can address the applicant's practical experience in the field.

Established in 2003, through the generosity of family and friends of Professor Chigurupati Rama Seshu. Born in India on June 15, 1935, he received his bachelor's degree in economics in 1956 from Andhra University, A.P, India, and his master's degree in economics from Saugor University, M.P., India. He moved to New York City in 1960 and earned his Ph.D. in economics in 1972 from the New School for Social Research. Seshu arrived in New Paltz as a visiting lecturer in the department of economics and business administration in 1967. In 1972, he was promoted to associate professor. He was Director of Institutional Research from 1974 to 1977.

The selection and criteria process will be as follows:

- A. Preference will be given to students who major in economics.
- B. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.2.
- C. Applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of five upper division economic courses during the two semesters of aid.
- D. Applicant must be matriculated as a full-time student.

The Baggerman Family Scholarship Fund memorializes the lives of William and Susanna Baggerman, parents of William Jr. and Susan. Susan M. Baggerman received her Bachelor of Science degree in elementary education in 1957, and a certificate of advance study in educational administration and supervision in 1972, from SUNY New Paltz. She was an elementary teacher for 36 years at the Newbridge Road School in North Bellmore, Nassau County. In addition to any application form which may be required by the Scholarship Committee, applicant(s) must provide documentation they have attended either North Bellmore (New York) Public Schools or Pine Bush (New York) Public Schools. It is the donor's wish that the Scholarship Committee first seek to award the Baggerman Family Scholarship to a student(s) who attended either North Bellmore (New York) or Pine Bush (New York) public schools, who meets the following selection criteria. In the event that there is not such an applicant, the Committee is directed by the donor to award the scholarship to a student(s) who meets the following criteria.
