

## Graduate School Scholarship for Teacher Candidates in Adolescence Education

The Graduate School Scholarship for Teachers in Adolescence Education is offered to recognize academic excellence and to prepare teachers in adolescence education in math, science, Spanish, and French. The State University of New York at New Paltz offers a limited number of scholarships to highly qualified applicants. Consideration will also be given to financial need.

### Eligibility

To be considered, applicants must demonstrate the following criteria:

- ✓ Overall undergraduate GPA of 3.2 or better
- ✓ Matriculation in the SUNY New Paltz MAT or MEd in Adolescence Education in one of the following programs: Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, French, Spanish, or Math
- ✓ Registration each semester or summer session in at least three credits of graduate work toward this degree. Students who do not register for two out of three sessions (fall, spring, summer) will not be eligible for the scholarship in the first semester of their return.
- ✓ Maintenance of good academic standing of 3.2 for each semester or summer session of matriculation

### Awards

Successful applicants in the Master of Science in Adolescence Education (MSEd) or the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) programs will receive a pro-rated tuition waiver for up to 3 graduate credits per year (at the New York State resident rate) based on the candidate's enrollment during the fall, spring, or summer semesters.

- 3-credit waiver if enrolled in 9 or more graduate credits
- 2-credit waiver if enrolled in 6-8 graduate credits
- 1-credit waiver if enrolled in 3-5 graduate credits

### How to Apply

You may be considered for an award once your application to the MSEd or MAT program at SUNY New Paltz is complete and if you meet the 3.2 GPA requirement. To apply, please submit the following documents:

2. A statement of well-defined academic and professional goals
3. A signed statement explaining current financial needs and resources
