Incanizing the World Heritage City: Quechua Women, Indigeneity and Dilemmas of Inclusion in Cuzco, Peru

Dr. Mathews-Salazar examines the desires and expectations of residents of Cuzco, Peru to maintain their World Heritage status. As authorities implement various regulations to protect Inca heritage, these efforts expose conflicting notions of indigeneity, citizenship, and belonging among its residents. Her talk focuses on the reactions provoked by the presence of women of two nearby communities who regularly come with their llamas to these sites.
