The Art Education Program requires the following:

- 1. Students need to be admitted to the Art Education Program (move from a Pre-major 00AE to a Major 189) before they can enroll in ARE302 Curriculum and Instruction.
- 2. Students should not start the next course in the Art Education sequence if they have an incomplete in the preceding prerequisite course.
- 3. To be accepted as a major in the Art Education Program, students need a minimum 3.00 GPA.. (Matriculation F09, transfer Spring '10)
- 4. In order to apply, the student must turn in a completed application form at the given date (usually Mid-October and Mid-March).
- 5. In order to student teach., students should complete the S.A.V.E. and Child Abuse Recognition workshop, have a health clearance, a minimum 2.75 GPA, and all major courses must have a C or better.
- 6. All transfer credits applicable to the Art Education program must be evaluated and approved before the student is fully admitted to the Art Education program. This includes any elective studio credits, which may need to be re-evaluated by the appropriate studio faculty.
- 7. Transfer students: courses that are not approved as equivalent to SUNY New Paltz courses will not count towards the major in the program.
- 8. A maximum of 27 studio credits may be transferred, but a minimum of 50% of program credits MUST be taken at SUNY New Paltz.
 - 1 Any transferred classes must have a grade of B or better.
 - 2 All major courses must have a C or better.
 - 3 Other graduation requirements are: 48 liberal arts credits & 45 upper division credits
 - 4 To obtain NYS certification through the SUNY New Paltz Art Education Program, students must complete 2 semesters of a foreign language.

There is a 120 total credit requirement for majors and 150 total credit requirement for double majors. All students should refer to the advising handbook for degree requirements.

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
