3A <u>Multi-Subject Content Specialty Test (CST) for Birth-Grade 2</u>

3 B <u>Multi-Subject Content Specialty Test (CST) for Grades 1-6</u>

- Recommend taking at end of Methods 3 or during Student Teaching
- Three parts to each test; the third part is common to both tests
- All parts are computer-based, and self-scheduled at a test center
- Fee varies depending on how many parts of each test you take on the same day

4 <u>edTPA (Teacher Performance Assessment)</u>

- Multiple-measure portfolio assessment which evaluates pre-service teachers' readiness to teach
- Will include videotaped lessons from Student Teaching semester
- Details and preparatory material on Blackboard (edTPA community)
- Fee approximately \$300
