None of the following situations qualify as sufficient to merit a change to independent status:

- Parents refuse to contribute to a student's education.
- Parents are unwilling to provide information for the application or verification.
- Parents do not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes.
- Student demonstrates total self-sufficiency and does not live with parents.
- In rare cases such as a documented abusive family environment, complete parental abandonment, both parents currently being incarcerated or institutionalized, or if neither parent can be located, a Dependency Override may be granted by a Financial Aid Administrator. In order for a Dependency Override to be considered documentation must be submitted which substantiates the special or unusual circumstances of an individual student and may include, but is not limited to:
 - o Court Documents.
 - o Police Reports.
 - o Death Certificates.
 - O Submission of a court order or official federal or state documentation that the student or the student's parents or legal guardians are incarcerated in any federal or state penal institution.
 - o Supplementary information, as necessary, about the financial status or personal circumstances of eligible applicants as it relates to the special circumstances or unusual circumstances based on which the applicant is requesting an adjustment.
 - O Signed letters from professionals who are aware of the student's situation (high school counselors, therapists, case workers, clergy member, or another impartial source familiar with your situation in a professional capacity). These letters should be on professional letterhead and must be signed.

If you believe that you should be considered for a Dependency Override and are able to provide the required documentation, please submit this form with the accompanying necessary documentation to The Office of Student Financial Services.

If you have concluded that your situation does not meet the stated criteria and would like to withdraw your request for Independent status, you will need to update your 2023-2024 FAFSA record to include your parent's information and FSA ID. You will also need to change your answers to the Independence questions to No. If you are having difficulty with this process please contact the Office of Student Financial Services and ask to speak with a Financial Aid Advisor. The decision to change a student's dependency status is based on the administrator's judgment and is final and cannot be appealed to the U.S. Department of Education. Transfer students who have been approved as Independent previously at another institution are not automatically independent at SUNY New Paltz and must provide documentation of their situation.
