The Samuel Dorsky Museum of Art at SUNY New Paltz is pleased to announce Steven Holl as our Special Honored Guest at Art Uncorked 2018

- The Dorsky Museum's Art Uncorked Benefit and Auction is the single largest source of funding for the museum's exhibitions, publications and public education programs. This year's event will be held on October 17, from 6 – 9 pm at The Century Association in NYC. Art Uncorked will be a lively evening attended by 150 museum patrons that will include wine tastings, silent and live auctions of works of art, fine wines, and memorable experiences.
- Considered one of America's most important architects, Steven Holl is recognized for his ability to blend space and light with great contextual sensitivity. He specializes in seamlessly integrating new projects in contexts that have cultural and historic importance. Founded by Holl in 1977, Steven Holl Architects has realized cultural, civic, university, and residential projects in the U.S. and around the world, most recently the Lewis Arts Complex at Princeton University (2017) and Maggie's Centre Barts in London, United Kingdom (2017). Currently under construction is the Expansion Project for the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts and the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston Campus Expansion. As the principal and lead designer of Steven Holl Architects, Holl has been recognized with several international awards, including the 2014 Praemium Imperiale International Arts Award for Architecture and the AIA 2012 Gold Medal Award. He is a tenured professor at Columbia University's Graduate School of Architecture and Planning.

The exhibition *Steven Holl: Making Architecture*, on display at The Dorsky Museum at SUNY New **Paltz February 10 - July 15, 2018** is the first museum exhibition to explore this Hudson Valley master's creative influences and his significant impact on contemporary architecture.

• The Samuel Dorsky Museum of Art at the State University of New York at New Paltz (The Dorsky) is located at the geographic center of the SUNY New Paltz campus and is one of the largest museums in the SUNY system, with more than 9,000 square feet of exhibition art space distributed over six galleries and a permanent collection of over 6,000 works of art.
