3. Please note: this major requirement can be replace with POL227(Intro International Politics) or SAB003 (Upper Division Study Abroad Elective). If you choose either option, you must adjust your 4 year plan to include course to fulfill DIVR general education requirement
4. BUS450 is for majors only; must have taken BUS341 previously; must be a senior
5. All 400 level Business courses are for Majors Only (Competency)
6. See Director of MBA Program for selection and approval of MBA courses
7. Pre-Requisites: BUS325 & BUS346
8. Pre-Requisites: MAT171 or MPL 5 or higher

### Degree Requirement:

1. Completion of a minimum of 120 academic credits
2. Completion of the General Education program. Please refer to the University's GE requirements.
3. Completion of a minimum of 60 credits of Liberal Arts. See above for the LA credits from the courses in your Major.
4. Completion of a minimum of 45 credits in upper division courses. See above for the UD credits from the courses in your Major.
5. Completion of the Major's requirements. See the courses in the above table.
6. Completion of a minimum of 30 degree credits in residence. The final 15 credits towards the degree must be in residence.
7. One-half of the student's major must be taken at New Paltz.
