

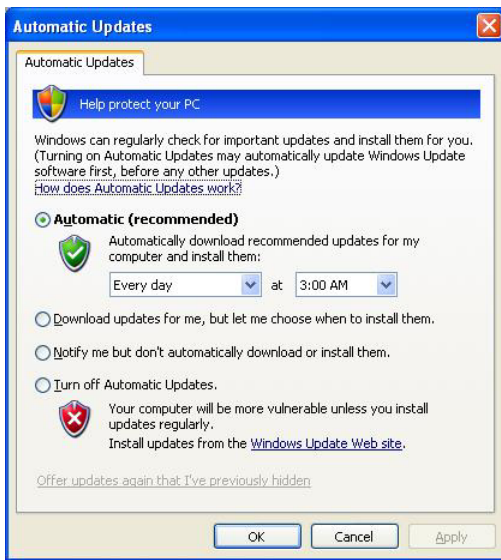
# Turning on Automatic Updates.

- 1) Click on “**Start**”
- 2) Click on “**Control Panel**” (For Win98/ME & 2000 first click on “Settings”)

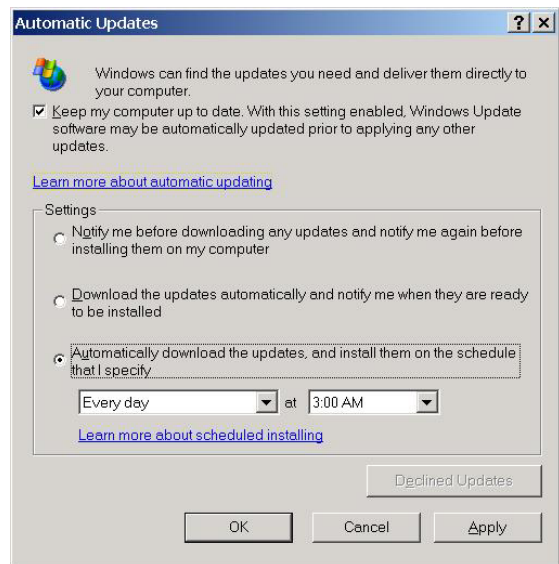
- 3) Double click on the “**Automatic Updates**” Icon.



4) *The next screen may differ depending on your Windows version, but the goal is to turn on the Automatic Update function and have it download & install the updates automatically.* Here are two versions of what you might see:

- 5) After activating the Automatic Update function, select a time when your system is most likely to be on & not in heavy use.
- 6) Click “**OK**” . . . (And your done!)

\* **Note** – If there are Updates that your system needs, they may download immediately which may temporarily cause your system to respond a little slow.
