

Determinations by Chair of
Not Human Subjects Research

The investigator will e-mail the IRB Chair a description of the proposed research project giving a rationale for designation of research as not human subject research as defined in 45 CFR 46 (refer to definitions below.) A full description of the type of data to be collected must be included. It is recommended that a copy of all interview or survey items that will be administered also be included.

The IRB Chair will respond by e-mail or telephone to the inquiry within 10 days requesting additional information as necessary.

The Chair will copy the IRB Secretary, the Provost and the Human Protection Administrator on all correspondence.

45 CFR 46, Section 102

46.102 (d)

Research means a systematic investigation, including research development, testing and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge.

46.102 (f)

Human Subject means a living individual about whom an investigator (whether professional or student) conducting research obtains

- (1) Data through intervention or interaction with the individual, or
- (2) Identifiable private information.
