Challenges to drinking water focus of Jan. 31 event at SUNY New Paltz

NEW PALTZ, N.Y. >> The Benjamin Center for Public Policy Initiatives at SUNY New Paltz will host a discussion on Jan. 31, titled “Our Drinking Water Challenges: Infrastructure, Local Water, and Protecting Open Space.”

The event, in collaboration with the village of New Paltz and state Department of Environmental Conservation’s Hudson Estuary Program, will be from 6:30 to 8:15 p.m. in Room 181 of Science Hall on the New Paltz campus. It is free and open to the public.

The program will feature remarks from three speakers who have experience with New York state water delivery systems, as well as a panel discussion that will include time for audience questions. The speakers are Sabrina Ty, president and chief executive officer of the New York state Environmental Facilities Corporation; Tracy Hitchen Boyd, assistant comptroller for the state’s Division of Local Government and School Accountability; and Marilyn Wyman from Cornell Cooperative Extension.
