- *4 The Foreign Language requirement for GE4 may be fulfilled by completing two consecutive elementary-level courses or one intermediate-level (or above) course. The number of courses needed is based on students' prior experience in the language i.e., their Language Placement Level (LPL), which appears on the Progress Report.
