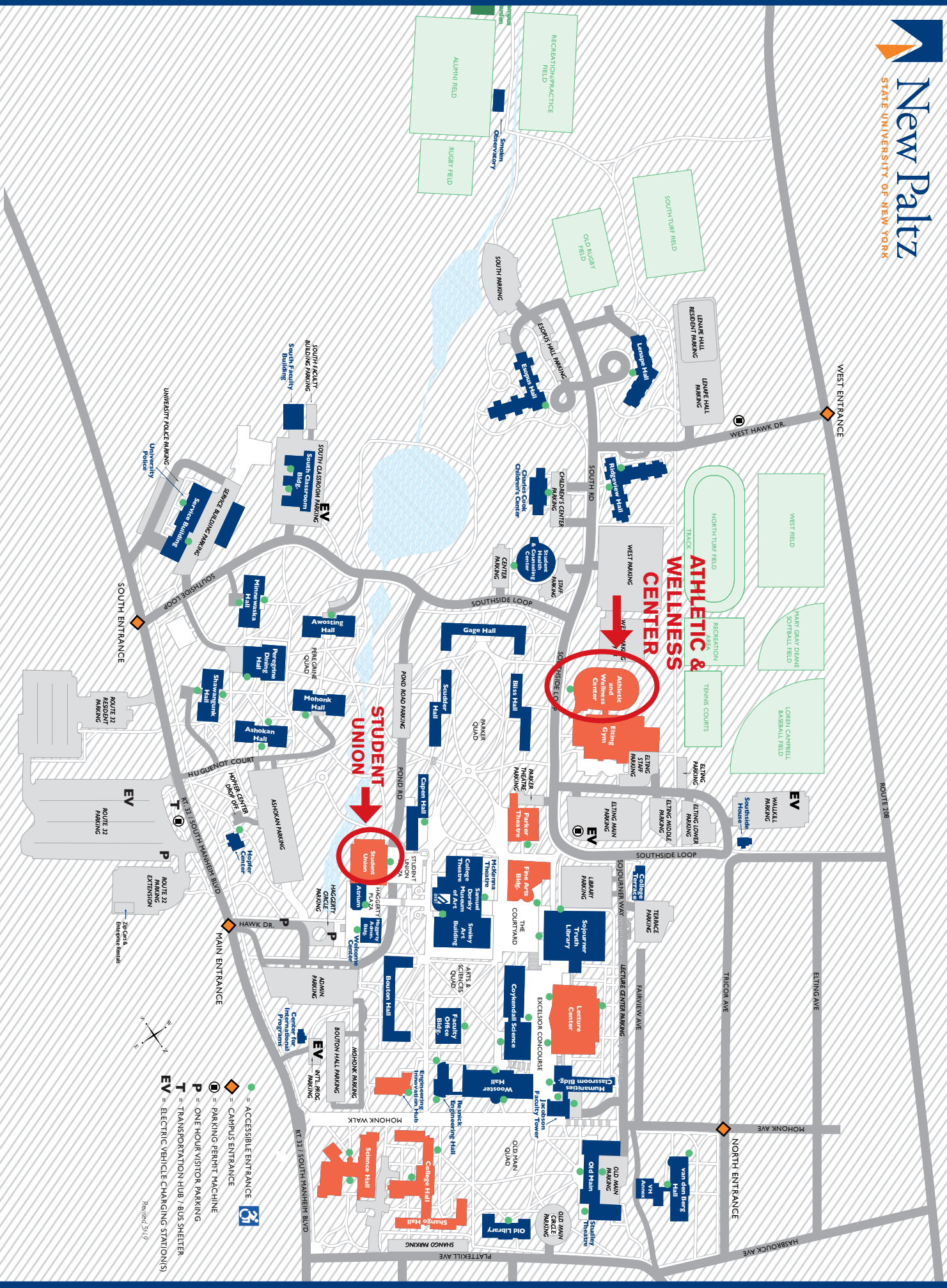
CAMPUS TOURS
