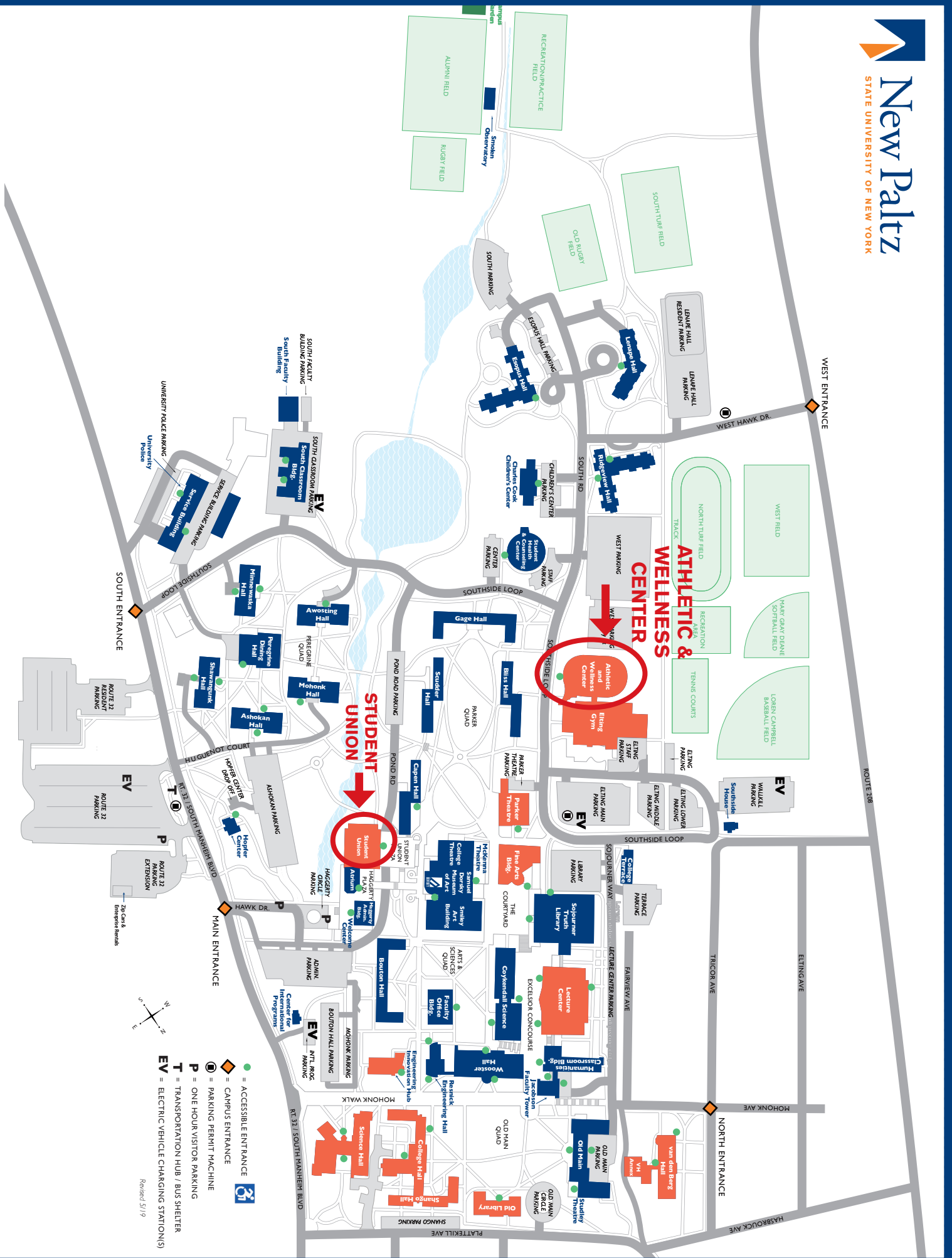
CAMPUS TOURS
