Mid-Semester Progress Survey & What it means for you!



What is the Mid-Semester Progress Survey?

The Mid-semester progress survey is housed in <u>Starfish</u> and allows for the quick collection of faculty feedback about your performance in class. The feedback they provide inform you and your advisor(s) about your academic progress so far this semester.

• What kind of feedback will I receive?

Your instructors will submit their feedback regarding your progress in class via Starfish in the form of <u>flags or kudos</u>.



Flags: Used by faculty or staff if they have a concern about your academic performance. If received, it is important to talk with your instructor and/or meet with your advisor.

Kudos: Raised by faculty to acknowledge you for a job well done!



• What should I do, if I receive a flag?

If you receive a flag during the Mid-Semester Progress Survey (or at any point in the semester) follow these **three** recommendations:

- 1. Communicate with your instructor.
- 2. Contact your advisor.
- 3. Utilize campus support services:
 - Center for Student Success
