

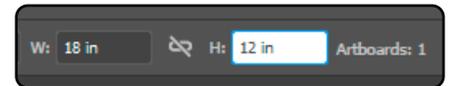
# ***Is your Illustrator file ready for the Laser Cutter?***

---

Go through the file you are bringing to the laser cutter and make sure it meets the criteria below. If it does not, your file is not ready for the laser.

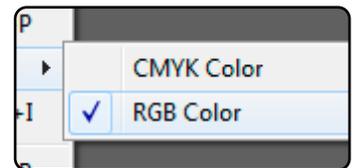
## ***Is your Artboard size 12”H x 18”W?***

Shift + O > Enter 18” W by 12” H in the top control panel



## ***Is the document color mode RGB?***

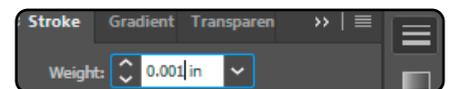
File > Document Color mode > Choose RGB



## ***Is the stroke weight of your cut lines .001?***

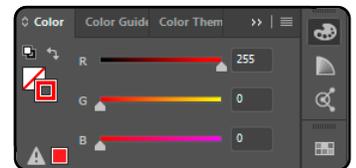
Select the object > Ctrl + F10 > stroke weight .001\*

\*the unit value for your stroke should be set to inches



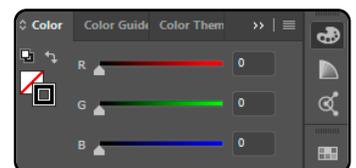
## ***Are your cut lines RGB Red?***

Select the object > F6 > RGB Red values: **R255, G0, B0**



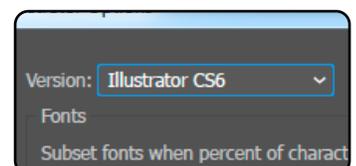
## ***Are your engraving objects RGB Black?***

Select the object > F6 > RGB Black values: **R0, G0, B0**



## ***Is your files saved as Adobe Illustrator CS6?***

File > Save As > Save > Version: CS6
