- Parents are unwilling to provide information for the application or verification.
- Parents do not claim the student as a dependent for income tax purposes.
- Student demonstrates total self-sufficiency and does not live with parents.

If you have concluded that your situation does not meet the stated criteria and would like to withdraw your request for Independent status, you will need to update your 2022-2023 FAFSA record to include your parent's information and FSA ID. You will also need to change your answers to the Independence questions to No. If you are having difficulty with this process please contact the Student Financial Services Office and ask to speak with a Financial Aid Advisor. The decision to change a student's dependency status is based on the administrator's judgment and is final and cannot be appealed to the U.S. Department of Education. Transfer students who have been approved as Independent previously at another institution are not automatically independent at SUNY New Paltz and must provide documentation of their situation.
