

■ Admission Requirements

- Official transcripts in sealed envelopes, (high school average 85% or higher)
- Local and state board scores, if available
- TRANSFERS: Minimum GPA 2.75 (Evaluation of non-US university transcripts by NACES approved agency is recommended)
- Admission essay (personal statement)
- 1 letter of recommendation
- Official standardized exams, if available (SAT/ACT not required)
- IELTS 6.5, TOEFL iBT 80 (Conditional Admission offered)
- Copy of passport - after admission, required for I-20
- Financial documents (bank statement) - after admission, required for I-20

Application fee of \$50 required for processing

■ Application Deadlines

- December 1 for Spring semester (January start)
- June 15 for Fall semester (August start)

■ Annual Tuition and Fees

Tuition: \$16,980

Mandatory university fees and foreign student health insurance: \$3,522



- 1 Pay the \$100 application fee online
- 2 Send documents (scanned copies):
 - Copy of passport
 - Financial documents (bank statements)
 - Proof of high school completion (high school transcripts)
- 3 Wait to receive your I-20 in the mail
- 4 Make an appointment with the U.S. consulate
- 5 Send additional documents from the Welcome Packet that will be sent with your I-20:
 - Airport pick-up form
 - Health form
 - Attendance confirmation
 - Housing license (residence hall/dormitory) form
- 6 Continue checking your email for updates and important information
