WHO: You! This is a conference for instructors, faculty, staff, and industry partners interested in Advanced Physics Laboratories beyond the first year in undergraduate education.

WHAT: This Regional ALPhA Conference has three goals:

1) **Networking.** To facilitate networking and cooperation among Advanced Lab folks in the New York region. Meet others interested in improving labs, get ideas, and get local help implementing them.

2) **Hands-on Experience.** There are workshops and tours that participants can sign up for. These get everyone in the lab doing an experiment or set of experiments. This is a fun way to get ideas or try something new.

****Special Make-and-Take workshop!** Participants will be introduced to MicroPython and the TinyPICO microcontroller with applications of an environmental sensor, an alpha particle counter, or an I-V diode curve measurement. This workshop must be pre-registered and has a cost of \$40.

3) **Enhance Your Teaching.** Hear four speakers share their work on teaching techniques and experiments for the Advanced Lab and share your own ideas in breakout sessions.
