When can you register for spring 2023?

Avoid delays!

Major/Minor declaration moratorium

Planning to declare your major or add a minor? This is a great idea to do prior to registering for classes. Classes may be restricted to majors or minors. Students in a major or minor have access to these courses whereas other students will be blocked and require permission to register.

Declare your major or add a minor no later than October 30. Many departments will not declare new majors or minors October 31-November 20 to allow for time to advise current majors and minors.

Vaccine Compliance for *in-person* Classes

The COVID vaccine mandate is in-effect for all SUNY students to enroll for in-person classes. If you have uploaded your vaccine documentation in the vaccine portal, there is nothing further to do.
