

Science of Reading Fundamentals For-Credit FAQ

Who is eligible to apply for Credit for College-Level for the Science of Reading Fundamentals Microcredential?

All learners who have completed the Science of Reading Fundamental microcredential and received an 80% or better on all modules are eligible for credit.

What is the process to apply for graduate credit for the Science of Reading Fundamentals Microcredential?

To apply for credit, learners must complete the Credit for College Level Learning (CCLL) application: <https://admissions.newpaltz.edu/register/ccll>

Learners who successfully complete the Science of Reading Fundamentals microcredential on or after April 15, 2025, will receive information in their course completion email with instructions on how to apply for credit.

How much does it cost to apply for graduate credit for the Science of Reading Fundamentals Microcredential?

Learners who successfully complete the Science of Reading Fundamentals microcredential may apply for credit, at no cost. If approved for credit, learners may choose to request an official transcript, through our third-party vendor (Parchment). Each official transcript cost \$10.00, paid directly to Parchment.

Can the graduate credit, earned after completion of the Science of Reading Fundamentals microcredential, be transferred to another school?

Transferability is at the discretion of the other institution. Learners will need to consult with their transferring institution.

Once a learner successfully completes the Science of Reading microcredential, is there a deadline for applying for graduate credit?

Once a learner successfully completes the Science of Reading Fundamentals microcredential, there is no deadline for applying for graduate credit.

I have successfully completed the Science of Reading Fundamentals microcredential and applied for graduate credit. How long will it take for graduate credit to get awarded?

Once a learner's application is approved for graduate credit, it may take up to 7-10 business days for the credit to get awarded.
