abroad are essential for management and leadership positions. Student safety is a primary concern in Study Abroad, and SUNY New Paltz prioritizes the health and security of its students through:

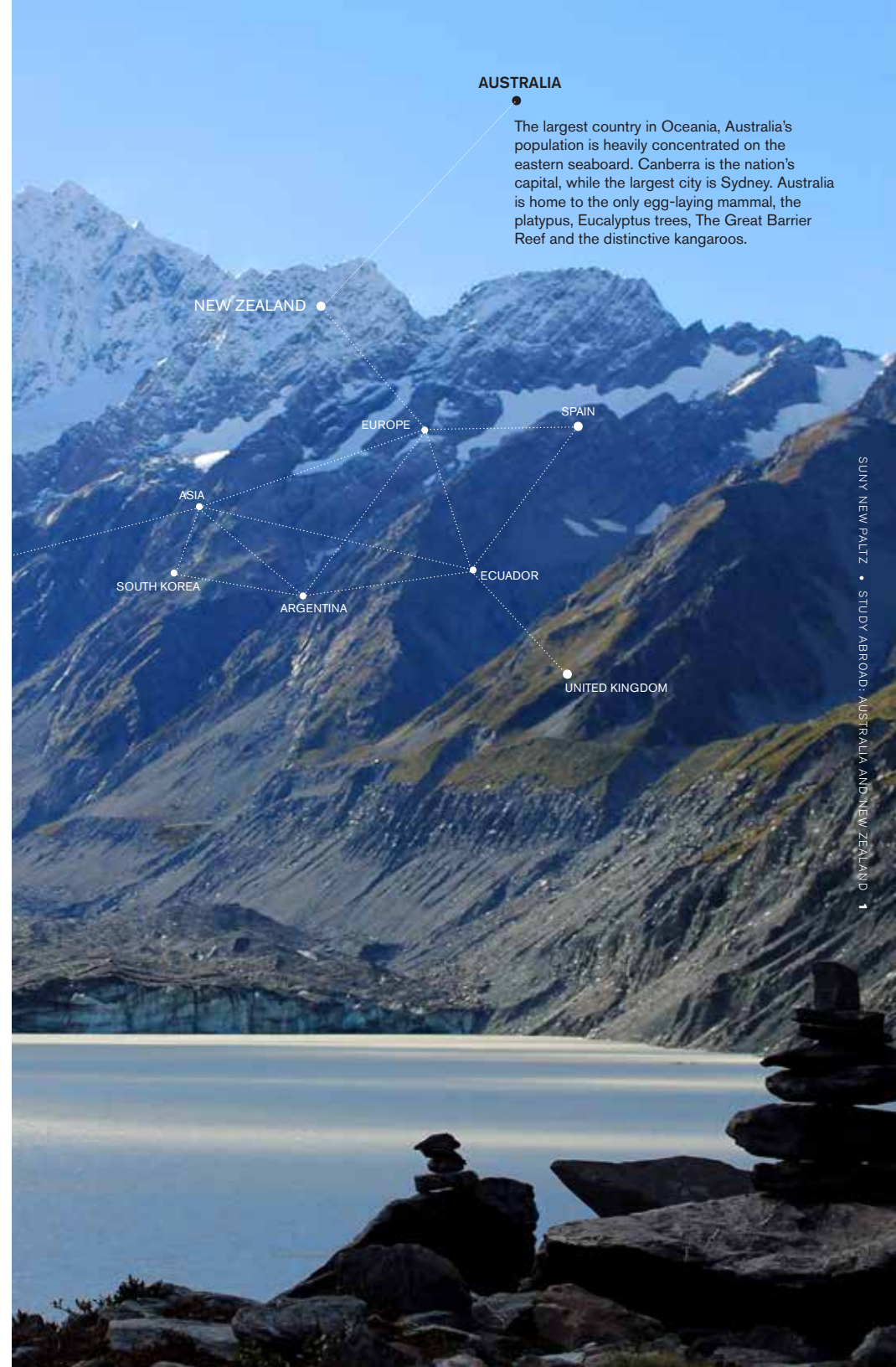
- One-on-one student advising;

Wellington is the cultural center of New Zealand and the southernmost capital city in the entire world. It is New Zealand's political and cultural center, and currently has the 12th best quality of living in the entire world. The culture of Wellington is a diverse and often youth-driven one with a large social scene. Coffee culture in Wellington is vastly overrepresented and the city has more cafes per capita than New York City.

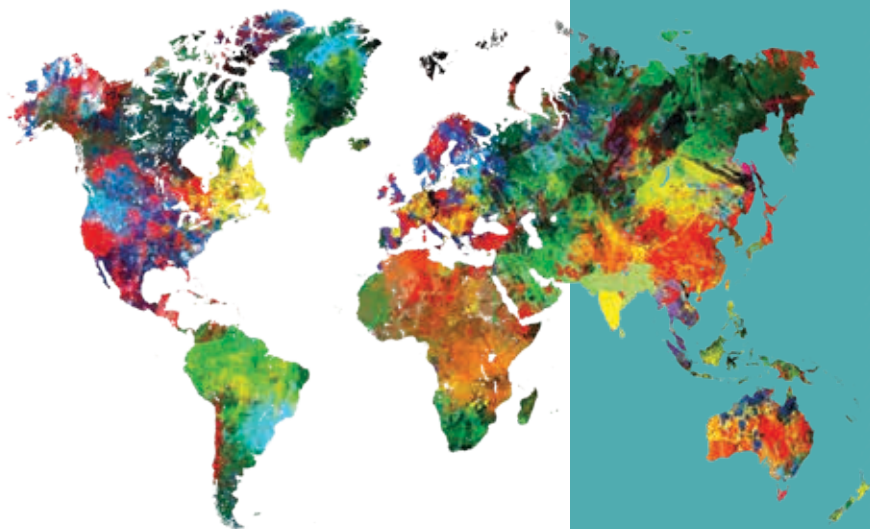
■ “Catered” and “Self Catered” Halls are available. All meals are provided in all the catered halls. To-go meals are provided if you cannot return to the hall.
