State redistricting proposal focus of Oct. 22 debate in New Paltz

NEW PALTZ >> The Center for Research, Regional Education and Outreach at SUNY New Paltz, along with the League of Women Voters of the Mid-Hudson Region, will sponsor a debate on revising the redistricting process in New York state.

The question of the redistricting process, which will be known as Proposal 1 on the Nov. 4 election ballot, will be debated Oct. 22 at 7 p.m. at Deyo Hall. If approved, the proposal would create a redistricting commission to establish state Senate, Assembly and Congressional districts in New York.

Dick Dadey, executive director of Citizens Union, will speak for the plan, while Gerald Benjamin, director of the Center for Research, Regional Education and Outreach and associate vice president for regional engagement, will speak against it.

The event is free and open to the public.
