Report examines local grads' career readiness

NEWPALTZ » A 2020 Vision for Public Education in Ulster County, a broad-ranging effort to support innovation and positive change in Ulster County schooling, has released its sixth policy brief: "Career Readiness for Employment-Seeking High School Graduates in Ulster County." The report explores how Ulster County school districts are acting to meet the goal of producing career-ready high school graduates.

Gerald Benjamin, director of The Benjamin Center, said the report examines the meaning of "career readiness," data on the employment market in Ulster County and the Hudson Valley, and the "skills gap" identified by employers. The paper closes with descriptions of some of the initiatives that school districts in Ulster County have developed to respond to the challenge.
