



Context, motivation, structure of program

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




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Exploring ways that student engagement around sustainability is (or is not) evolving to mirror the evolution we see in sustainability across higher education more generally?

....with a shifting focus toward deeper integration into curriculum, value systems and decision making, beyond our traditional focus on operations and culture change.....








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#### Education and Leadership Fellows in Sustainability




#### **Making Connections**

How this group of students made it happen.



#### Green it Forward

- A completely organic program at UB developed by students.
- **2**. Energy reduction by 10% or more over one week.
- **3.** Passive and active awareness cause.

\*Quick energy saving tip: turn off the lights in unused classrooms...you're allowed!


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

## LESSONS LEARNED: THE GOOD

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#### High Impact for ELFS:

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


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#### Impacts

- Student internships and opportunities




### LESSONS LEARNED: THE BAD

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- Differing levels of commitment and engagement
- Missed opportunity in not letting projects be wholly decided and designed by students
- Ambiguity of program expectations and impacts from student perspective
- Challenge with their being 2 projects
- Students wanted MORE, not LESS structure and training
- Advocacy vs. Activism vs. Adversary

## LESSONS LEARNED: THE UGLY

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


Lessons Learned: the ugly

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- Accountability for students
- Need to think intentionally about size of program
- Need to identify ongoing funding source
- Difficult overlap between ELFS and other UB Sustainability programs

- Risk of really over-programming students





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
